

## **BELT SANDER SAFETY**

- READ THE OPERATING INSTRUCTIONS BEFORE RUNNING MACHINE.
- · ALWAYS WEAR SAFETY GLASSES OR A FULL FACE SHIELD FOR PROTECTION.
- · KEEPS HANDS CLEAR OF THE SANDING AREA.
- · NEVER WEAR GLOVES OR LOOSE FITTING CLOTHES WHEN OPERATING THIS MACHINE.
- ALWAYS KEEP HAIR TIED BACK OR COVERED.
- · LET MACHINE ROTATION COME TO A FULL STOP BEFORE CHANGING BELT.
- KEEP SAFETY GUARDS IN PLACE. DO NOT ALTER GUARDS OR MACHINE IN ANY WAY. ANY ALTERATIONS TO GUARDS OR MACHINE COULD CAUSE SERIOUS INJURY.
- ALL BELT SANDERS SHOULD BE OPERATED IN A WELL-VENTILATED AREA. THE DUST CREATED WHEN SOME MATERIALS ARE SANDED CAN BE HARMFUL. DUST MASKS ARE RECOMMENDED AS A PRACTICAL MEANS OF MINIMIZING DUST INHALATION. FUMES FROM OTHER SOURCES CAN ALSO CAUSE FIRES WHEN IN CONTACT WITH SANDING SPARKS.
- SPARKS CREATED BY SANDING SHOULD BE DIRECTED DOWNWARD AND AWAY FROM THE FACE AND BODY. DO NOT GRIND NEAR FLAMMABLE MATERIAL.
- ELECTRIC SANDING MACHINES ARE NOT INTENDED FOR USE IN OR NEAR WATER. THIS INCLUDES AN OPERATOR STANDING ON A WET FLOOR OR WORKING AROUND CONTAIN-ERS OF WATER OR OTHER CONDUCTIVE LIQUIDS.

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Basic Operation: Model S460W Wet Belt Sander

Sanding belt size 4"x60"

3HP, 1ph 110 or 220 volt / 3HP, 3ph, 220 or 440 volt

NOTE: Disconnect power before servicing machine.

<u>Belt Changing</u> - Use lever #3 to release sanding belt tension. Pull lever to compress spring, remove and replace sanding belt. Push lever back to tension sanding belt.

Belt Tracking - Use tracking knob #19 to track or "center" the sanding belt. Rotate sanding belt by hand to be sure of sanding belt centering. When sanding belt remains centered on the steel platen (#6) tracking is complete. Connect AC power and "jog" on/off switch to be sure sanding belt stays in the center of the platen and is tracked correctly.

<u>Platen</u> - Steel plate of "platen" is behind the sanding belt. It will wear over time and can be flipped over to use a new surface area. Remove cap screws on the platen and flip for new surface area.

<u>Work Table</u> - Always keep work table within 1/8" of sanding belt. Too large a gap will allow work pieces and fingers to get pinched. CAUTION: DO NOT WEAR GLOVES!!!

<u>Maintenance</u> - Keep machine clean. Flip or rotate platen when impressions wear into it. No grease is required. All bearings are sealed for life.

<u>Trouble shooting</u> - Basic machine needs very little maintenance other than tracking the sanding belt. If sanding belt does not stay tracked typically the drive pulley (#27) has lost its "crown". The drive pulley is tapered down from the center out to each edge slightly. This makes the sanding belt stay in the center or "tracked".

Safety - Always wear safety glasses. Do not wear gloves.
